EPASS: Accessing Your Information

As of November 18, 2008, all licensees are required to use ePass to renew their licenses. EPass allows access to all authorized eGovernment services with one username and password, allows customers to personalize their services page, shows customers other government services that may be useful to them, and may, in the future, grant access to federal government services for which you are authorized.

Some of you may have already established an ePass userID and password for other State of Montana online services. If you have an established ePass account, you will need to log in to ePass (www.epass.mt.gov) with your current userID and password, then add the link you need to access for your real estate license ([https://app.mt.gov/renewal/.](https://app.mt.gov/renewal/))

For those of you who do not have an ePass userID and password, you can go to www.epass.mt.gov and “Create a New Account”. Then, simply add the links for license renewal (<https://app.mt.gov/renewal/>). Your login information for renewal will be saved under your ePass profile – no more need to remember PIN numbers and license numbers.
